We further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of any dog(s) by disappearance, theft, death, injury, or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog(s), whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage, death, or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of any and/or all of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

We hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons including ourselves or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of our participation in the dog classes/activities, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons.

INSTRUCTIONS

Dogs being evaluated for TDI certification must be 12 months old on the day of the evaluation and handled by the person who will pursue therapy dog visitations with that dog. The certification is for that particular team and is not transferable. Each person wishing to visit with a particular dog must test with that dog.

Deciding which evaluation to register for:

CGC Only:

- Dogs that are not old enough for Therapy Dogs International, Inc. (TDI) certification but that want to be evaluated for the AKC Canine Good Citizen (CGC) certification (6 months but less than 12 months old on day of evaluation).
- Over 12 months, but the owner does not want to pursue therapy dog visitations and only wants the CGC certification offered by the AKC for their dog.

TDI Only:

- Dogs that owners want to pursue therapy dog visitations with and have evaluated for TDI certification, and have already received a CGC certification at some previous event.
- Dogs that owners wish to be evaluated for TDI certification, have not previously received CGC certification, but do not wish to or care to receive CGC certification. Registrants for “TDI only” will not receive separate documentation to send to AKC for a CGC certificate. They will receive documentation for TDI certification only.

CGC & TDI Combined:

- Dogs that owners want to pursue therapy dog visitations with and have evaluated for TDI certification, and have not previously received a CGC certification, and wish to receive CGC certification. Registrants for “CGC & TDI Combined” will receive separate documentation to send to AKC for a CGC certificate. They will receive documentation for TDI and CGC certification.

- A copy of your dog's current vaccination records must be included with the registration form (rabies, distemper, hepatitis, parvovirus are required, leptospirosis and parainfluenza are at the discretion of your vet).

One, two, or three year vaccinations are acceptable. If the dog cannot be vaccinated, there must be a proven clinical condition. A signed clinical diagnosis from a veterinarian must be provided and attached to vaccination records. In the case of titers, a letter from your veterinarian explaining the reason for their use is required. A statement from the vet “in my professional opinion the dog should not be vaccinated” will not be accepted.

- Please be sure to visit the Therapy Dogs International website at www.tdi-dog.org for information regarding the evaluation requirements.

Bring with you to the evaluation:

- Buckle or quick-snap collar, or plain harness; no training collars, prong, martingales, haltis, gentle leaders, etc.
- Six foot leash – leather or fabric; no chains or metal, no retractable leashes.
- A grooming tool your dog is familiar with (comb, brush, etc).
- Treats your dog really enjoys.
- Water for your dog, and clean-up materials.

Any sign of aggression towards another dog or a person at any time while at the evaluation, whether during the actual evaluation phase or not, will result in immediate dismissal from the evaluation site.
