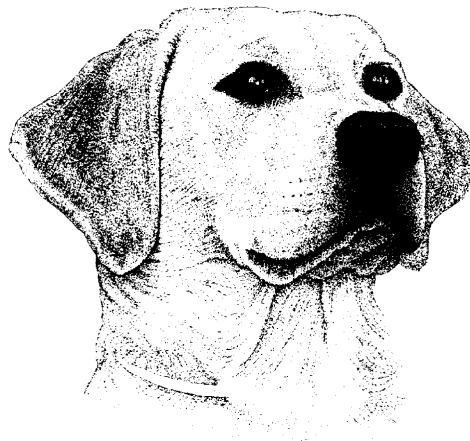

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or members show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or members show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or members show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or members show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or members show.

If because of Riots, Civil Disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Postdated Checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$35 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor will result in disbarments from future shows of the LRCP.

No Refund for duplicate entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Errors on entry blanks: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whomever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Show Secretary data entry errors should be brought to the Secretary's attention so that official catalog records can be corrected.

The LRCP Board, wishing to expand its activities in the field, in tracking and in support of genetic research has chosen to offer a second specialty as a means to reward the conformation and obedience communities and permit them to help underwrite the cost of those activities that promote the multiple purposes of the breed. In choosing to offer this "bare bones" specialty, the LRCP is harkening back to the spirit of self-sufficiency, cooperation, friendship and spontaneity of matches and the Club's early shows. The LRCP wants to drop all pretensions and encourage a lot of fun, so here are our rules for this show:

1. Despite the appearance of lots of committees, this is a do-it-yourself show. We'll provide flat grass and good judges, you bring the dogs and we'll call it a dog show.
2. BYOE (Bring Your Own Everything!) (except judges): To guarantee you have what you want and need for this show (chairs, lunch, water, etc.), be sure to pack it before you leave home.
