

Potomac Motor Home and RV Parking

Rules, Regulations and User Agreement

Saturday, April 9, 2016 to Friday, April 15, 2016

- Potomac exhibitors wishing to park a motor home or recreational vehicle at the host hotel must make advance reservations with the LRCP. Payment must be received at the time the reservation is made.
- The motor home/RV reservation fee is \$155 for all or for any part of the show if received prior to 4/6/2016. Reservations made after that date will be \$180.
- Be advised that if you park before 10:00 AM Saturday, April 9, 2016, you may be forced to move your vehicle at the sole discretion of the RV Coordinator.
- Motor homes and RV's may be parked only in the designated RV parking area.
- No hookups are available
- No discharge of gray water of sanitary tanks on the ground or in open containers is permitted. Please contact the RV Coordinator for information on sanitary tank pumping services.
- If sawdust or shavings are used, they must be cleaned up before you leave.
- Use of this facility is at your own risk. Neither the LRCP, Inc. the Show Committee, the Holiday Inn nor the RV Coordinator assumes any responsibility or liability for damage or loss to any vehicles, their contents, or dogs.
- Fire lanes must be kept open at all times. Vehicles parked illegally or blocking, or in an area other than the designated RV area will be subject to towing at owner's expense with no prior notice.
- Exhibitors are responsible for any damage, and for cleanup of their own RV spaces.
- Exhibitors parking in the area designated for motor home and RV parking are specifically notified that the property adjacent to the Hotel is private property and may **NOT** be used to air your dogs. Violators will be asked to leave the hotel.
- RV parking is a privilege extended by the Holiday Inn and the Specialty Committee. Exhibitors are asked to be considerate of their neighbors. The RV Chair has the authority to allocate space and to ask that any problems be remedied.
- All motor homes and RV's must have a working fire extinguisher and must fully comply with the appropriate fire and safety ordinances.
- The RV Coordinator will provide a sticker when you arrive which must be displayed in a visible location on your motor home or RV.
